

Using Google Drive to Host an Articulate Presentation

Pros

- Easy to do
- Can share the URL over and over again
- Will be available as long as the account remains open (and Google maintains its webhosting service)

Cons

- The presentation is public to whoever has the URL – there is no option to share selectively to individuals or to one website
- Uses an individual Google account (alternatively, a general account can be created for a department)

How it's Done

Note: It is recommended to use the Google Chrome browser for the best experience. If you use Firefox, you will need to download a Java applet to be able to upload an unzipped folder.

1. Login to Google Drive: <https://drive.google.com>

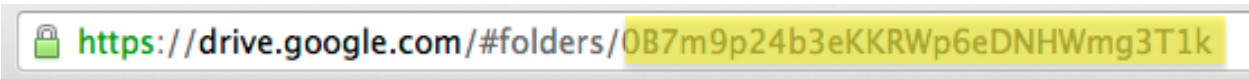
2. Create  a new folder.

3. Using the **Share** button , set this folder's sharing settings to "Public on the web"

4. **Upload**  the unzipped published output from your Articulate project to the folder. (This may take a while depending on how big the presentation is.)

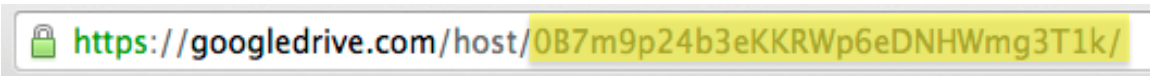
5. Once the files are done uploading, right-click the presentation_html5.html file and rename it index.html

6. From within the folder containing your published content, copy the characters after "drive.google.com/#folders/" from the address bar.

7. Then, to get the link you to use for sharing with others, paste those copied characters to the end of "http://googledrive.com/host/". You will be able to share this link via uploading to a webpage or sharing with others for viewing without them needing to download anything.
