

Biostat 202: Orange Data Mining Download Guide

Goal: The goal of this document is to assist you in downloading Orange Data Mining, the primary software used in the course.

If you run into any difficulties or have any questions, contact the course director Aaron Scheffler (aaron.scheffler@ucsf.edu) for assistance prior to July 30. He will be available to meet with students on Zoom.

Notes: There may be variability in your installation experience due to your operating system, do not be surprised. Seek assistance ahead of time if you cannot complete these steps or your installation experience differs from the steps described.

Download instructions:

1. Visit <https://orange.biolab.si/download/#macos> (MacOS) or <https://orange.biolab.si/download/#windows> (Windows) and download the installation package (ignore the Anaconda instructions).
2. Open the installation package and follow the specified instructions.
3. Open the software once installed to verify the software was installed correctly. You can even try one of the examples provided upon opening.
4. Please contact aaron.scheffler@ucsf.edu if you encounter any troubles *before* the first class. We have lab on the first day of class so the software must be running by that point.
