Create Online Presentations with the Articulate '13 Studio

Online presentations are easy to create using the Articulate '13 software that works seamlessly with Microsoft Office PowerPoint. Users can record narration, annotate, and add quizzing and interactions to PowerPoint slides for a more engaging learner experience. Articulate files can be uploaded to the CLE and viewed with other online course content.

What's New with Articulate '13?

Users already may be familiar with Articulate Studio '09. The same publishers have released the suite of products with enhanced features and functionality. Check out some of the notable features below:

Publishes output to HTML5

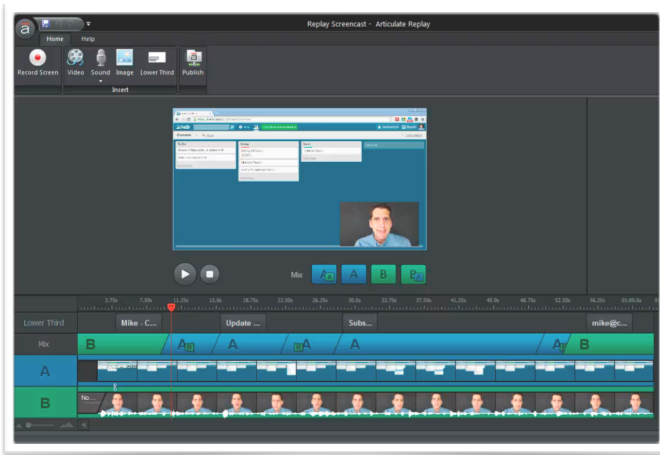


In addition to publishing to Flash files for the web, Articulate users now have the capability to publish to HTML5 output for better iPad and mobile device compatibility. Learners can resume a course exactly where they left off as they shift from device to device.

Articulate Replay screencast software

Replay is brand new to the Articulate Studio. Users can now capture screencasts (video recordings of computer desktop and any open programs) and record webcam video. Users can toggle between which video is the main display and which displays picture in picture.

Users can import other audio, video, images, text (like diagrams or title screens). The product also allows for "lower thirds" display, which acts like a news ticker to show names, titles, key words, etc.

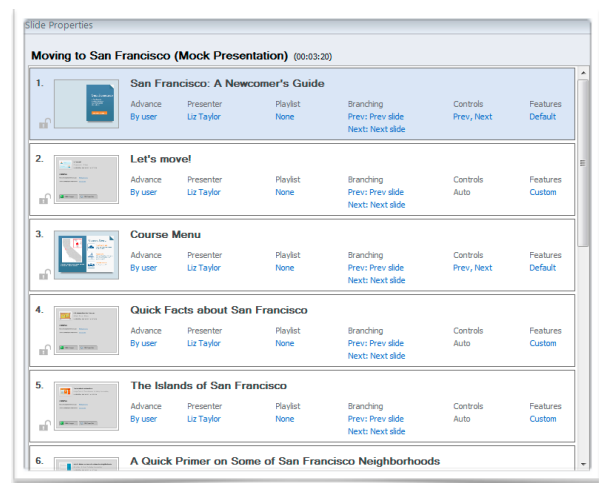


Faster publishing

Users should experience faster publishing times with the newer software. Articulate claims up to five times faster.

Streamlined user interface

Articulate '13 offers improved functionality in the slide properties window. For example, the product supports non-linear navigation and more sophisticated branching. Users can control the navigation on each slide and whether or not the slide has a Previous or Next button. Also, users can easily switch between views.

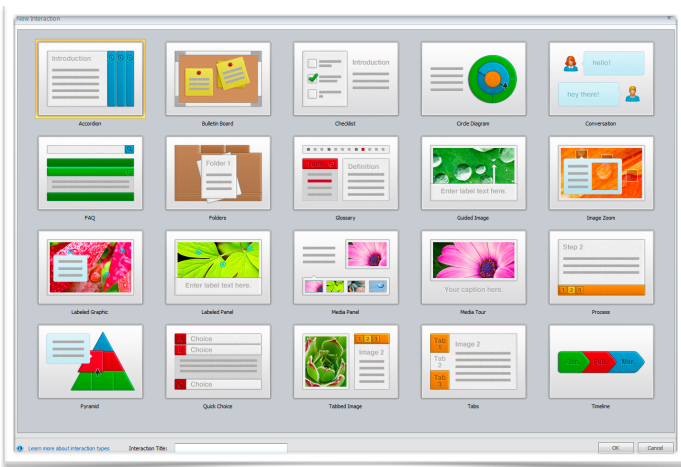

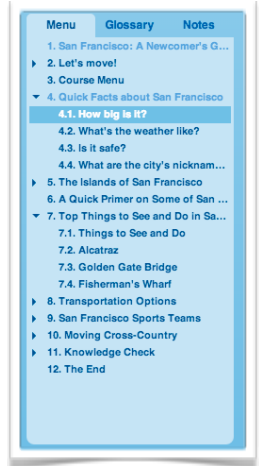
Updates with Quizmaker '13

Users can also take advantage of customizable question feedback layers, in which images, text, characters, etc. can be added. The feedback position can also be changed, so that it never covers up answer choices. The new 'Feedback Master' allows you to create a consistent style and edit all the layers at once.

The interface is lighter and modernized allowing for more straightforward editing and previewing. You can add text, multimedia, and image content to your interaction all in one simplified window. Also, while the previous interactions are improved, ten new interaction types were added!



The new integrated player controls and interface makes navigation easier for both users and learners alike. Now, it's easier to edit the menu items and users have the option of listing all slide titles, quiz questions, and interactions steps on a single, consolidated menu. Users also experience greater control over the player, such as what features to display (ex. Title, Menu, and Resources).



- **Animations:** users can apply more advanced animations, such as to GIFs, SmartArt, and text letter by letter
- **Video:** Users can import video in virtually any format
- **Exit tab:** Users have the option of displaying an 'Exit' tab next to 'Resources' in the upper corner of the
