

Antepartum Visit Guidelines

FREQUENCY OF VISITS:*

1-28 weeks: every 4 weeks

28-36 weeks: every two weeks

36 weeks until birth every week

TIMING OF LABS: (for low risk pregnancies)

Initial Visit: CBC, ferritin, urine culture, blood type, antibody screen, rubella titer, syphilis screen, pap smear, gonorrhea, chlamydia, HBsAg, HIV, hepatitis C, A1C if before 13 weeks (GLT if >13 weeks & risk factors), varicella titer, PPD if risk factors.

Dating sono

8-20 weeks:

10 weeks or greater: Offer: NIPS

11²-14² weeks: Offer: Nuchal Translucency

15-20 weeks: Offer: second trimester serum screen

11-13 weeks: CVS

15-20 (16-18) weeks Amniocentesis

24-28 weeks: CBC, ferritin, GLT, RPR, HIV
Antibody screen (if Rh negative)

27-36wks: Tdap

32-36 weeks: Gonorrhea, chlamydia (depends on risk factors)

36-37 weeks: Group beta strep culture
Position check
