#1

+ PPD

S: Denies Hx of + PPD.
Denies TB exposure. Denies night sweats, bloody sputum, fever or lethargy.
O: + PPD 3/1/20 15 mm x 20 mm
Lungs clear
A: r/o TB; IUP 10 weeks
P: CXR next visit.

#2

Family history DM

S: 28 y.o. patient states mother with IDDM from age 30.
Denies GDM with previous pregnancy
O: Pre-pregnant wt: 137 lbs. BMI – 25.
Urine dip - neg glucose
A: Risk of GDM, IUP 14 weeks
P: Early GLT

#3

S>D

S: Unsure of LMP states aprox. (2/1/20), → EDC 11-8-21 → EGA 16 weeks. No contraceptive use x 9 months. Sexually active during last year.
Regular cycles q28 days
LMP normal in amount and duration.
+FM x 1 wk
O: FH - @ U. FHT 140
A: IUP 16 weeks by unsure dates
S>D
P: Sonogram
Quad marker screen today
Discussed probable date change with patient
Discussed possibility of positive AFP r/t unsure dating

O: GLT done 1/27/21 - 114

A: normal GLT

repeat GLT 26-28 wks.

P: pt. education re/test results

#3

S>D

S: Unsure LMP

O: Sono 1/30/21 → EGA 24 weeks

single living fetus, anterior placenta

FH 24 cm today, FHT 140 F.S.

A: IUP 24 weeks by sono

Size = sono

P: sono → dates

Pt. education re/sono results and new EDC

Quad marker screen from 12/18 to be recalculated with new EDD.
